The Phoenix Outdoor Centre is running its 8th annual **Bell Boat Regatta** on the Welsh Harp Reservoir in West Hendon on **Friday 7th June 2019**. The event is supported by **Decathlon UK Staples Corner** and the team will be present on the day with soft archery games and other activities planned. The event is open to one team per school consisting of 10 pupils from Year 5 or 6, plus 2 adult members of staff. (If there are spare places, we will open up to two teams per school after the closing date of 25th May). This is a fun competition open to primary schools in North London and surrounding areas, with a shield for the winners for fastest time over a set course and prizes for all participants.



All participants should be able to swim 10m or be water confident wearing a buoyancy aid. We would recommend that the students wear PE kit including footwear in the boat and have their normal school clothes to go home in. They may get splashed, but there is a low risk of an accidental swim, however, feet can get wet, so bring dry shoes to go home in. We will provide buoyancy aids and windproof cagoules. Each Bell Boat has a Coach / Helmsman on board and there will be a Safety Boat on the water. We will provide schools with a copy of our Risk Assessment prior to the event.

Pupils may bring a packed lunch to eat at the centre (depending on the time of activity) and we will find you somewhere suitable to picnic.

Each school will have a 1.5 hour slot to take part in the competition including safety briefing, practice and changing time and there will be additional activities off the water.

To enter a team, contact us to pre-book your preferred time slot and we will send you a Booking Form to complete and return with your entry fee. We don't need your team participant names before the event, but will send you a Parent Permission Form which will need to be provided for each pupil taking part on the day.

We look forward to welcoming your school to the Phoenix Outdoor Centre.
